5 Ports	1 Port	4 Ports/2 Inland Terminals

1. These ports were surveyed for possible deployment of the Offshore Petroleum Discharge System (OPDS), Single Anchor Leg Mooring System (SALM) and the beach interface unit for contingency purposes. Information is contained in the 1997, East coast port survey.

2. These ports are commercial refinery ports utilized to off load crude oil and load refined products for both export and consumption within Korea.

3. This port is a commercial facility utilized by refineries to off load commercial product in the Kunsan area. This port is also utilized by the US Government to off load JP8 in support of Kunsan Defense Fuel Supply Point (DFSP) and Kunsan air Base.

4. Pohang DFSP is owned by the Republic of Korea and operated by a commercial contractor in support of the US Government to off load government product into the Pohang base terminal storage facility and movement into the Trans. Korea Pipeline.

5. Inland Terminal (Mokpo has access to both inland terminal via barge/coastal tanker).
